


THAMMASAT



Established in 1933, Thammasat University is the second oldest university in Thailand. The university's founder, Prof. Dr. Pridi Banomyong, originally named Thammasat the, "University of Moral and Political Sciences." The name reflects the university's primary mission to offer higher education in the disciplines of law and politics to the citizens and prepare Thai people for their new democratic system.

Initially a law school, Thammasat University gradually expanded to offer courses in Social Sciences, Humanities and Sciences with the aim of providing higher education in the fields that are pertinent to social need and promoting research of Thai culture. Since its inception, Thammasat University has evolved from an open university for law and politics to a prestigious international university offering academic degrees of all levels. More than 300,000 of the students who graduated from Thammasat University have gone on to make great contributions to the development and progress of Thailand to match the rapid pace of world's globalization. Several members of the alumni have served in various prominent positions, such as Prime Ministers and successful business people. Thammasat University alumni and graduates have served the country at the local, national, and international levels in almost all areas of work. Presently, 84 years after its establishment, Thammasat University continues to follow its philosophy of upholding academic excellence while promoting and servicing social justice and equality.

BBA INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM



The Bachelor's degree in Business Administration (International Program), informally known as "BBA (International Program) or BBA for short, is a four-year undergraduate program in Business Administration offering three areas of concentration: accounting, finance, and marketing. All classes are conducted in English. BBA instructors are full-time faculty member of Thammasat University, visiting professors from universities overseas, and adjunct professors from the local business community. The program admits 120 students out of approximately 700 applicants per year.

Established in 1990, the BBA offers a unique opportunity for students to participate in the business school's worldwide exchange program under the Partners in International Management (PIM) network. Under PIM, a door is opened for BBA students to spend part of their educational experience in over fifty leading business schools across five continents.

Throughout their academic life with the BBA, students receive financial support in order to participate in case competitions, varsity debates, business essay competitions in domestic and international level.

TUBC HISTORY

THE CHALLENGER



The Thammasat Undergraduate Business Challenge, or TUBC, is a case competition for undergraduates from international business school. Hosted entirely by the students in Bachelor's degree of Business Administration program under Thammasat Business School, TUBC is renowned among local and international business communities as one of the most prestigious business case competitions ever established and as the first case competition held in Thailand.

TUBC 2018 marks the 21st year of the competition's ongoing legacy in the global business arena. Teams of undergraduates from top business schools around the world are invited to participate in this competition. Here at TUBC, teams will be given a business case based on a real current situation from the leading company in which they are required to provide the most strategically sound analysis and solution through their presentation and answers to questions conducted by the panel of honorable judges.

Objectives

- 1) To provide participants with the opportunity to utilize their knowledge and develop their skills, such as the ability to work under pressure with limited resources, the ability to analyze and solve problems, team work and time management.
- 2) To promote and develop global business networking among international business communities.
- 3) To prepare undergraduates for a rapidly changing global business environment.
- 4) To be acknowledged by international business schools worldwide as an international-standard business case competition.





he Challenger is a local business case competition that was initially organized by a small group of undergraduate committee that seeks for the opportunity to bring case competitions in Thailand to another level. The Challenger was developed under the idea of showcasing potential and skills of the undergraduates from all over the country, while also aiming to create a network among business people. Accordingly, 2012 is the outset of this event. Year after year, The Challenger has continually grown and improved. We were granted a great support from many leading companies and gained nation-wide recognition overtime. To this day, the competition continues to be run entirely by undergraduates in an effort of making it an interactive learning event for participants and those in associate. The committee dedicates their greatest effort to possibly provide the best business case competition in domestic level, reflected in its steady development.

This year the Challenger, a local business case competition integrated with TUBC (Thammasat Undergraduate Business Challenge) with the objective of qualifying the most proficient teams through a new reorganized format. Restructured for better integration of the two events, the Challenger invited local teams to compete for four available invitations to join the international arena at the TUBC. For a smooth transition, the event included top representative team from four different invited universities, whom automatically passed to the presentation round. These changes will be another page of success for The Challenger as it prepares for more in the years to come.
